

Consider another approach for non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC)

The **ROSETTA Lung-201 Trial (CA266-0001)** is a Phase 3 trial testing how safe and effective a proposed treatment is for adults with locally advanced, unresectable (cannot be removed with surgery) Stage III NSCLC that was previously treated with radiation therapy and chemotherapy together. This trial will compare the investigational treatment against the current standard-of-care (SOC) treatment (treatment that is accepted and widely used by healthcare professionals) for adults with locally advanced, unresectable Stage III NSCLC.

Clinical trials seek to advance and improve treatment options for a variety of conditions, including NSCLC. Phase 3 trials confirm findings from previous trials in much larger groups and evaluate the safety and effectiveness of the investigational treatment.

Key trial details

- **What's being studied?** An investigational treatment will be compared against SOC immunotherapy and chemotherapy
- **Who can participate?** Adults with locally advanced, unresectable Stage III NSCLC with any PD-L1 expression who have previously received radiation therapy and chemotherapy together
 - **Unresectable:** Cancer that is unable to be removed with surgery
- **How long is this trial?** The treatment period may last up to 1 year, with total trial participation lasting up to 5 years, depending on the participant's response to the trial treatment

Many trial-related costs will be covered, including visits, laboratory tests, and procedures. You may also be eligible for reimbursement for your time, travel, or transportation.*
